

### **Public Consultation Intent**

As required by Ministry guidelines, we are required to take the Stage 1 report to the community for feedback. This stage 1 document is essentially a long-list of possible options for managing wastewater that has been developed by the consultant with input from the advisory committee members. In the later stages 2 and 3, these options will be short-listed and analyzed by cost and other criteria, then shared with community through more open houses, etc, before any recommendations are made to the regional board.

### **Public Consultation Objectives**

- Increase awareness of work done on Area East LWMP and progress to-date
- Seek input from residents and businesses on the long list of options identified to-date
- Solicit any new ideas that could be considered
- Gain feedback on potential criteria that could be used to create a short-list of options
- Educate homeowners on the proper care and maintenance of septic tanks, new rules regarding installation, and various methods of wastewater treatment as identified in the long list of options.

### **Proposed Strategies**

- Proposed at last meeting to hold two open houses with a strong focus on septic tank education
- Tentative dates and locations: June 13 and 14 at Ellison and Joe Rich Community Halls
- Each would feature educational displays from the RDCO, Interior Health, a septic hauler and others as identified. (Ideas welcome!)
- Each would be promoted as a community social (e.g.: a “Septic Tank Social), including a free draw for a septic pump-out
- Promotional materials would include:
  - A newsletter/poster mailed to each home promoting the event as well as providing information about the LWMP options and septic tank care
  - Advertising in the RDCO section in the Capital News
  - Advertising/ article in the community newsletters (Joe Rich and Ellison)
  - Public service announcements on local radio stations
  - Info on RDCO phone “on hold” system and web site
  - Notices to community groups
  - Laminated posters for community halls and community mailboxes
  - Joe Rich sign board
