BENCH DONATION PROGRAM DETAILS

Bench Description

- The donation bench consists of a black powder painted aluminium frame with light beige recycled plastic lumber boards mounted to it. The bench is 6 feet long. See attached photo.

Cost

- \$1,500.00 taxes included (may be subject to change based on bench supply)
- Your donation covers the cost of a concrete pad, the bench, and a cast bronze plaque with 3 lines of text, and installation.
- A tax receipt, under Income Tax Act Section 118.1(1), will be issued for the entire donation amount.

Plaque

- Size of bronze plaque is 3" x 6".
- Engraved text to include a maximum of 3 lines of text and each line of text containing up to 25 characters (either letters and/or spaces).

Bench Locations

- There are suitable locations within most of the Regional Parks, and some Westside Parks.
- The Regional District Parks and Recreation Department is not accepting any further donation benches along the Mission Creek Greenway Phase 1 or 2.

Procedure for Making a Bench Donation

- Please read the bench donation contract attached.
- If you decide to make a donation for a bench, please call to arrange a meeting on site to view a suitable location for the bench placement.
- Once you have signed the contract and provided plaque inscription, and the donation money for the bench has been received, your order is considered complete.
- All benches ordered before March 31st of any given calendar year will be installed by the end of September in the same calendar year. Benches are ordered once annually and crews can only pour concrete during the summer months.
