

What usually happens at these parties?



One or two individuals from our office will come to your 'party' and present information on a number of topics including composting, grasscycling, water wise gardening and xeriscaping. Your guests determine the main topics, based on their gardening interests, questions or problems and then the floor is open to questions and discussion. At the end of the party the host receives a special gift and each guest also receives something to take home with them.

Who do I invite?

Us of course! Some people choose to have a private party involving friends and family, others have "block parties" where the neighborhood is invited. Other groups invite us as part of a normally scheduled meeting or AGM. We've even done small parties at businesses over their lunch break. It is up to you!

How long do the parties usually last?

The Go Natural presentation is usually one hour with time for questions afterward. Some have been a few hours; it all depends on the number of questions people have. They are lots of fun! Sometimes we need to 'escape' before the party gets too lively!

What about refreshments?

Refreshments are completely up to you although food is often a good draw. Sometimes the host or hostess provides drinks and snacks; others have made it potluck style. Refreshments have ranged from tea and cookies to community or block BBQs. Often the Go Natural parties 'naturally' extend into a regular get-together afterwards.
