BY-LAW # 41

Being a By-law to amend the 1971 Budget By-law # 37

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan deems it advisable to amend the 1971 Budget By-law #37, and

WHEREAS the cost apportionment of the function of the Sanitary Land Fill is to be made for the electoral areas of A, B, C, D, E, F, and the defined areas of G and I as defined in By-law #9 of the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the 14th day of November 1969 on the basis of the assessment of improvements only fixed for school purposes (excluding property that is taxable for school purposes only by special act) provided adequate facilities are available to accomodate a levy in this manner otherwise, on the basis of the assessment of land and improvements fixed for school purposes (excluding property that is taxable for school purposes only by special act) in the current taxation year

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:



READ A SECOND TIME the 7th day of April, 1971.




