

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 301

Being a bylaw to provide for the establishment of Advisory Planning Commissions for the Regional District of Central Okanagan

WHEREAS Section 955 of the Municipal Act RSBC 1979 provides that

- (a) A board may, by bylaw, establish an advisory planning commission for one or more electoral areas or portions of an electoral area to advise the board, or a director of the board representing the electoral area, on all matters referred to it by the board or by that director respecting the preparation and adoption of a community plan, or a rural land use bylaw or a proposed bylaw or permit that may be enacted or issued under this Part.
- (b) At least 2/3 of the members of the advisory planning commission shall be residents of the municipality or the electoral area of the regional district, as the case may be, and shall serve without remuneration, but they may be paid reasonable and necessary expenses that arise directly out of the performance of their duties.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting, enacts as follows:


1. That Electoral Area Advisory Planning Commissions for the following Electoral Areas are hereby established:

Electoral Area H
Electoral Area G


2. Each Advisory Planning Commission shall consist of not less than three nor more than seven members, all of whom shall be resident of the Electoral Area, and on the recommendation of the Electoral Area Director, members shall be appointed from time to time by resolution of the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
3. Each member appointed shall hold office at the pleasure of the Regional Board.
4. Should a vacancy or vacancies occur in the Commissions, the Regional Board shall by resolution, and on the recommendation of the Electoral Area Director, appoint a successor or successors who shall hold office under the terms set out in Clauses 3 of this bylaw.
5. All members of the Commissions shall be entitled to receive reasonable expenses that arise directly out of the performance of their duties, upon submission of a detailed account.
6. The Commission shall elect a chairman and recording secretary from among its members at its first meeting, who shall hold office until a successor is elected.

- 7. All recommendations of the Commission shall be decided by majority vote of the members.
- 8. A quorum is a majority of the members of the Commission and is required for the purpose of conducting the business of the Commission.
- 9. Minutes of all meetings of the Commission shall be recorded, kept, signed by the Chairman and Secretary and upon request, shall be made available to the public.
- 10. The Regional Board shall refer and the Commission shall consider and submit recommendations to the Board on matters respecting the preparation and adoption of a community plan, a rural land use bylaw, a proposed bylaw or permit that may be enacted or issued under and pursuant to Part 29 of the Municipal Act.
- 11. The Chairman, and if he is unavailable, any two members of the Commission may call a meeting of the Commission upon giving at least seven days notice to each member and a pro-tem Chairman shall be elected.
- 12. All suggestions and recommendations submitted by the Commission shall be duly considered by the Director or the Regional Board.
- 13. That Bylaw No. 240 cited as "Advisory Planning Commission Bylaw No. 240, 1982" is hereby repealed.
- 14. This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Advisory Planning Commission Bylaw No. 301 , 1986"




