BY-LAW NO. 391

---

Being a By-law to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding By-law No. 366, 1988.

---

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding By-law No. 366, 1988.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT Part III Control of Dogs Bylaw No. 366 be amended as follows:

1. To amend Section 20 to read as follows:

"On receipt of a complaint of a dog running at large or a dog tied, secured or tethered for a period longer than three (3) hours for each twenty-four (24) hour period, a dog owner shall be required to erect a secure fence or pen as described in Schedule 'D' of this Bylaw, within fourteen (14) days. If the fence is not built within the fourteen (14) days, a charge may be laid pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw."

THAT Part IV Impounding of Dogs Bylaw No. 366 be amended as follows:

2. To amend Section 43(a) to read as follows:

"For any contravention of Section 7(a), 7(b), 12, 13, 14, 15, 18, 19, 20 of this Bylaw, an information may be laid and/or a ticket issued by the Dog Control Officer in accordance with the provisions of the Offence Act (British Columbia) by means of the ticket set out as Schedule 'B' to this Bylaw which is hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Bylaw."


3. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Amendment By-law No. 391, 1989".


