

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 483

Being a bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding By-law No. 366, 1988.

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Bylaw under Bylaw No. 366, 1988, as amended by Bylaws No. 386, 1989, No. 391, 1990, and No. 444, 1991;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said Dog Regulation and Impounding Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT Part II - Licensing of Dogs be amended as follows:

i) Amend Section 8(e) to read:

'Should such license not be paid by the last day of February of the licensing year, the owner of any dog not so licensed shall pay a further fee of \$ 5.00'

ii) Amend Section 8(f) to read:

'For each Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Pit Bull, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Terrier, or any other dog of mixed breeding which includes any of the aforementioned breeds \$100.00'

iii) Amend Section 8(g) to read:

'If a dog is acquired or reaches the age of 3 months after March 1st in any license year, the owner thereof shall not be subject to paying the prescribed \$5.00 penalty.'

2. THAT Sections 21 to 51 inclusive of Bylaw 366, be renumbered to Sections 22 to 52 inclusive.

3. THAT Part III - Control of Dogs be amended as follows:

i) Amend Section 20 to read:

'Upon notification, a dog owner shall be required to erect a secure fence or pen as described in Schedule D of this by-law within fourteen (14) days. If the fence is not built within the fourteen (14) days, a charge may be laid pursuant to the provisions of this by-law.'

ii) A new Section 21 is inserted to read:

'Dogs are to be held within the kennel building between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.'

4. THAT Part IV - Impounding of Dogs be amended as follows:

i) Amend renumbered Section 32(b) to read:


'A maintenance fee of Five dollars (\$5.00) per day or part day of detention.'

- 5. THAT Schedule 'D', Standards for Fences/Pens, of Bylaw 366, is hereby deleted and the new Schedule 'D', Standards for Fences/Pens, attached hereto is substituted therefore.
- 6. THAT Schedule 'E', Standards for Dog Kennels, of Bylaw 366, is hereby deleted and the new Schedule 'E', Standards for Dog Kennels, attached hereto is substituted therefore.
- 7. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Amendment Bylaw No. 483 , 1991".







SCHEDULE D

Attached to and forming part of Bylaw No. 483 , 1991
(Dog Regulation and Impounding Amendment Bylaw)

Standards for Fences/Pens

1. Minimum standards for outdoor fences/pens for dogs in the Regional District of Central Okanagan shall be as follows:

- (a) Sizes: Pens - 3' x 5' per dog
Runs - 4' x 12'
- (b) Fences shall be of adequate height to contain the dog(s) or shall be covered and all gates shall be capable of being locked.

SCHEDULE E

Attached to and forming part of Bylaw No. 483, 1991.
(Dog Regulation and Impounding Amendment Bylaw)

Standards for Dog Kennels

1. Minimum standards for dog kennels for boarding, raising and training of dogs in the Regional District of Central Okanagan are as follows:

- (a) Sizes: Cages and pens within a kennel building shall be a minimum of 3' x 5' per dog.
- (b) Design and construction of kennel buildings must meet the British Columbia Building Code Standards.
 - (i) Exterior walls and ceiling shall have a Sound Transmission Class of 50.
 - (ii) Floor areas shall be constructed of concrete or wood, provided that the surface is treated or covered with a moisture resistant seal.
- (c) Heating and ventilation must be capable of meeting British Columbia Building Code Standards.
- (d) All gates shall be equipped with a locking device.
- (e) Permit: no person shall commence or continue to do any work related to a dog kennel structure unless a permit authorizing such work has been obtained from the Building Inspection Department.
