

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 888

Being a Bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Regional Crime Prevention Extended Service Establishing Bylaw No. 661, 1996.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Regional Crime Prevention Extended Service Establishing Bylaw No. 661, 1996;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said Crime Prevention Extended Service Establishing Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the participating areas are Electoral Areas 'G', 'I' and 'Westbank', the Corporation of the District of Peachland and the District of Lake Country;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with Section 813(1)(b) of the *Local Government Act*, at least 2/3 of the participants have consented in writing to the adoption of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assemble, enacts the following amendment to Regional District of Central Okanagan Regional Crime Prevention Extended Service Establishing Bylaw No. 661;

1. Delete Section 4 in its entirety and replace it with the following:
 4. As provided for in Section 817 of the *Local Government Act*, the annual cost of providing the service shall be recovered by the requisition of money provided for in Section 822 and 823 of the *Local Government Act*, to be collected by a property value tax to be imposed in the manner provided by Sections 824(1) and 825(1) of the *Local Government Act*. The maximum annual amount requisitioned for the purposes of this bylaw is \$0.0315 cents per \$1000. of assessed value to be levied and collected on land and improvements within the extended service area.
2. Throughout the bylaw, reference to Electoral Area H is amended to read, Electoral Area 'Westbank'.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Regional District of Central Okanagan Regional Crime Prevention Extended Service Amendment Bylaw No. 888, 2000.


