### BYLAW NO. 902

Being a Bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990.

- 2. In Section 3 of the Bylaw delete the words in parenthesis "(Schedules 2 through 12)" and replace them with (Schedules 2 through 13).
- 3. In Section 4 of the Bylaw delete the words in parenthesis "(Schedules 2 through 12)" and replace them with the words "(Schedules 2 through 13)".

This Bylaw may be cited as the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information and Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 902, 2000.
