

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 911

A bylaw to authorize the Regional District of Central Okanagan to dispose of a parcel of surplus regional parkland and the funds to be used for regional park acquisition purposes.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan operates regional parks as a service under Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 4 of the *Park (Regional) Act*, a regional district which operates regional parks as a service may, by bylaw, sell or exchange any land that is designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council as surplus to parks needs;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to sell a parcel of surplus parkland to acquire funds for the acquisition of other land which will better meet its needs for regional parks purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan is hereby authorized and empowered to dispose of the parcel of surplus parkland shown as Schedule A on the plan attached hereto;
2. The Secretary and Chairperson are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out the completion of the exchange authorized by this bylaw.
3. This bylaw may be cited as Regional District of Central Okanagan Surplus Regional Parkland Bylaw No. 911, 2001.


