BYLAW NO. 914

Being a Bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Weed Control Bylaw No. 179, 1979.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has established the service of weed control;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has enacted the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Weed Control Bylaw No. 179, 1979 and amendments thereto;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend said bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. Delete the existing definition for inspector in Section (1)1.(d) and replace it with the following:
 (1)1.(d) Inspector shall mean the Weed and Insect Inspector, Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Director of Inspection Services and any other person appointed or contracted to enforce or assist in the enforcement of this Bylaw.
2. Delete existing Section (11)3(c) in its entirety and replace it with a new Section (11)3.(c) as follows:
 (11)3 (c) and mulch or remove from the property any weeds and/or grasses that have been cut or that have been destroyed by a herbicide.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Regional District of Central Okanagan Noxious Weed Control Amendment Bylaw No. 914, 2001."


