
AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In Section 3 of the Bylaw delete the words "Schedules 2 through 13" and replace them with the words "Schedules 2 through 17".
2. In Section 4 of the Bylaw delete the words "Schedules 2 through 13" and replace them with the words "Schedules 2 through 17".
3. Schedule 1 (2000) shall be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with a new Schedule 1, 2004, attached hereto and forming part of the bylaw.
4. Schedules 14, 15, 16 and 17, attached hereto, shall be added to the bylaw and form part of the bylaw.

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information and Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 1055, 2004".
