Being a bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Smoke Control Regulatory Bylaw No. 773, 1998.


WHEREAS, The Regional District of Central Okanagan has enacted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Smoke Control Regulatory Bylaw No. 773, 1998;

AND WHEREAS, the Regional District of Central Okanagan considers that it is necessary to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Smoke Control Regulatory Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Delete Section 4.2 in its entirety and replace it with a new Section 4.2:
"Only untreated seasoned wood with a moisture content of 20% or less shall be burned in a wood burning appliance or fireplace."
2. Add a new Section 4.5:
"Wood burning appliance fires shall be maintained so as not to cause a nuisance for more than two minutes in succession except during a fifteen-minute period following re-firing of the appliance. This fifteen minute exemption will only be permitted once during a two hour period."
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Regional District of Central Okanagan Smoke Control Regulatory Amendment Bylaw No. 1059, 2004.
