

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 1060

Being a bylaw to amend the Regional of Central Okanagan Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990.

WHEREAS, the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990 and amendments thereto;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Delete the first three sentences of the Bylaw that read:

“WHEREAS Section 934.1(1)(a) of the Municipal Act empowers the Regional Board, by bylaw, to designate those bylaws for which municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS Section 934.1(1)(c) of the Municipal Act empowers the Regional Board to, by bylaw, authorize the use of any word or expression on a municipal ticket information to designate an offence against a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Section 934.1(10) of the Municipal Act empowers the Regional Board to, by bylaw, set fine amounts in consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court;”


And replace them with:

“WHEREAS the Local Government Act and the Community Charter authorize the Regional District of Central to enact a bylaw to provide for bylaw enforcement utilizing ticket offences.”

2. In Section 1 delete the words “for the purpose of Section 934.1(1)(a) of the Municipal Act,” and replace them with “by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.”
3. In Section 2 delete the words “pursuant to Section 934.1(1)(b) of the Municipal Act.”
4. In Section 4 delete the words, “pursuant to Section 934.1(b) of the Municipal Act.”
5. Schedule 11, (1997) shall be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with a new Schedule 11, 2004 attached hereto and forming a part of the bylaw.
6. Schedule 13 shall be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with a new Schedule 13, 2004 attached hereto and forming a part of the bylaw.

7. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information and Utilization Amendment Bylaw No.1060, 2004.

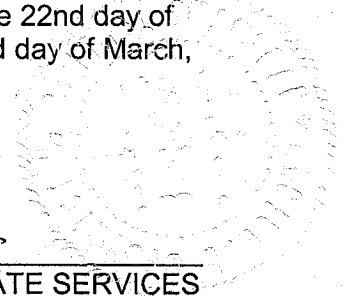
