

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 1065

Being a bylaw to establish a service of fire prevention and to amend Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw 404, Wilson's Landing Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 416, Ellison Fire Protection Local Services Establishment Bylaw No. 418, Regional District of Central Okanagan North Westside Road Fire Protection Local Service Area Establishment and Expansion Bylaw No. 548, Regional District of Central Okanagan June Springs Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1021, Regional District of Central Okanagan Brent Road Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1044, Regional District of Central Okanagan Lakeshore Road Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1058.

WHEREAS the Local Government Act requires that a Regional District Board must first adopt an establishing bylaw for a service;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to establish the Service of Fire Prevention for those areas of the Regional District that are not within the boundaries of the District of Peachland, the City of Kelowna, or the District of Lake Country;

AND WHEREAS the Directors of the Westside Electoral Area and the Director of the Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area have consented to the establishment of the service area;


NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The fire prevention services established by this bylaw shall be limited to the following activities:
 - a) Education of the residents about fire hazards.
 - b) Adoption and enforcement of regulations dealing with fire prevention.
 - c) A system of fire prevention inspections of public buildings.
 - d) Adoption and enforcement of fire department access standards.
 - e) Supplemental Regulations for fire hydrants.
 - f) Regional District Fire Department Administration.
2. The boundaries of the fire prevention services established by this bylaw shall include all of Westside Electoral Area and Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area.
3. The participants in the service are the Westside Electoral Area and Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area.
4. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned for the annual operating costs for the service shall not exceed \$0.15 per \$1,000.00 of the net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.

5. The annual costs of operating the service shall be recovered by property value taxes imposed on the net taxable value of land and improvements in the participating area, and fees and charges imposed in accordance with Section 803 of the Local Government Act.
6. To amend the "Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw 404, 1989" by deleting in Section 1.a) the words "and prevention".
7. To amend the "Wilson's Landing Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 416, 1990" by deleting in Section 4(a) the words "and prevention".
8. To amend the "Ellison Fire Protection Local Services Establishment Bylaw No. 418, 1990" by deleting in Section 4(a) the words "and prevention".
9. To amend "The Regional District of Central Okanagan North Westside Road Fire Protection Local Service Area Establishment and Expansion Bylaw No. 548, 1993" by deleting in Section 5(a) the words "and prevention".
10. To amend the "Regional District of Central Okanagan June Springs Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1021, 2003" by deleting in Section 6(a) the words "and prevention".
11. To amend the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Brent Road Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1044, 2003" by deleting in Section 6(a) the words "and prevention".
12. To amend the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Lakeshore Road Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1058, 2004" by deleting in Section 6(a) the words "and prevention".

This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Fire Prevention Services Establishment Bylaw No. 1065, 2004".




