Being a bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 1162.

WHEREAS, the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 1162, 2006, as amended;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Delete Schedule "D" in its entirety and replace it with new Schedule "D", attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Solid Waste Management Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 1203 ,2007".

SCHEDULE "D"

SANITARY LANDFILL / RECYCLING FEES

1. The following rates shall be paid for all Garbage delivered to the Westside Sanitary Landfill or the Glenmore Sanitary Landfill at all times when the landfill scale is operating:
 - (a) Demolition, construction, and land clearing waste material:

(i) source-separated recyclables	\$ 10.00 per metric tonne
(ii) gypsum drywall	\$145.00 per metric tonne
(iii) mixed waste for disposal	\$55.00 per metric tonne
 - (b) All other residential Garbage \$ 55.00 per metric tonne

2. At all times when the scales are not operating, all refuse delivered to the Westside or Glenmore Sanitary Landfill shall be subject to the following charges, according to the type of vehicle delivering the refuse and without taking into consideration the volume or weight of the refuse contained in the vehicle:

Utility Trailer, or Vehicles up to 3/4 ton	\$6.00
Tandem Axle Trailer	\$40.00
Side Dump Collector Truck, less than 50m ³	\$75.00
Side Dump Collector Truck, equal to or greater than 50m ³	\$150.00
Curbster	\$250.00
Roll-off Open Container, 15 yard bin	\$80.00
Roll-off Open Container, 20 yard bin	\$95.00
Roll-off Open Container, 30 yard bin	\$155.00
Roll-off Open Container, 40 yard bin	\$200.00
Roll-off Closed Compactor Unit, up to 40 yard	\$325.00
Large Compactor, greater than 40 yard	\$360.00
Single Axle Truck (1 ton)	\$60.00
Single Axle Truck (2 ton)	\$85.00
Single Axle Truck (3 ton)	\$125.00
Single Axle Truck (5 ton)	\$170.00
Single Axle Truck (dump)	\$190.00
Tandem Axle Truck (dump)	\$280.00
Tractor Trailer Unit	\$325.00
Source Separated Recyclables	\$10.00

3. All Garbage hauled directly to the Sanitary Landfill site by residential customers shall be subject to the following minimum charges:
 - \$1.00 per bag up to six (6) bags
 - \$6.00 per load of garbage weighing up to and including 250 kg
 - \$55.00 per metric tonne for garbage weighing greater than 250 kg

4. Owners of all Residential Dwelling Units, including Owners of property who have received a Waiver of Service, will be levied annually on their property tax notice or utility bill a charge of \$58.65 to cover Sanitary Landfill refuse disposal costs, recycling programs and waste reduction activities. New accounts will be billed from the date of request for final inspection on a pro-rated basis.

5. Notwithstanding Section 1, 2, or 3 of this Schedule, there shall be a \$25.00 per metric tonne tipping fee charged for clean Wood Waste brought to the Sanitary Landfill.
6. New or used gypsum shall be collected at the Sanitary Landfill for recycling at a cost of \$145.00 per metric tonne or portion thereof.
7. Notwithstanding Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Schedule, Yard and Garden Waste shall be subject to the following charges:

• Weight under 250 kg	No charge
• Weight over 250 kg	\$25 per metric tonne
• Branches under 20 cm (8 inches), up to 2m in length	Subject to weight restrictions (see above)
• Branches over 20 cm (8 inches), up to 2m in length	\$55 per metric tonne
8. Notwithstanding Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this Schedule, the following rates shall be charged for disposal:

• Tires up to 16 inches (40.64 cm) in diameter, w/ rim	\$1.00 each
• Tires 16 to 25.5 inches (40.64 - 64.77 cm) in diameter, no rims	\$5.00 each
• Tires 16 to 25.5 inches (40.64 - 64.77 cm) in diameter, w/ rims	\$10.00 each
• White Goods	\$25.00 / tonne (min. \$6.00)
• Clean, asphalt and concrete (less than 1 tonne)	\$25.00/tonne
9. Notwithstanding Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this Schedule, the following rates shall be charged for the following materials:

• Asbestos (friable)	\$150.00 per metric tonne
• Hydrocarbon Contaminated Soils	\$8.00 per metric tonne
• Recyclable corrugated cardboard larger than 1 m ³	\$10.00 per load
• Ash	\$100.00 per tandem axle load
• Carcasses weighing under 100 kg	\$55.00 per metric tonne
• Carcasses weighing over 100 kg	\$200.00 per carcass
10. Notwithstanding Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this Schedule, there shall be a \$30.00 per metric tonne surcharge, over and above the \$55.00 per tonne tipping fee, for any materials determined by the Director of Engineering to require burial in an area away from the regular Sanitary Landfill area.
