

**REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN**

**BYLAW NO. 1263**

---

Being a bylaw to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Handi-Dart Transit Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 419, 1990.

---

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has adopted the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Handi-Dart Transit Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 419, 1990 and Regional District of Central Okanagan Handi-Dart Transit Local Service Area Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 965, 2002";

AND WHEREAS upon the incorporation of the District of West Kelowna, the service of transit was not transferred to the municipality but remained as a service of the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the District of West Kelowna has expressed a desire to assume responsibility for Handi-Dart Transit Services within their boundaries and the Regional Board has agreed to this;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said local service area to delete the District of West Kelowna (formerly known as a portion of Electoral Areas 'G' and 'H') and redefine, as a result of incorporation of the District of West Kelowna, the new boundary for the Central Okanagan West Electoral Area which will include only IR#9 and IR#10, as a participating member;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the District of West Kelowna and the Director of Central Okanagan West Electoral Area have consented in writing to the adoption of this Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional District of Central Okanagan, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That clause 1 be amended to remove as a result of incorporation the District of West Kelowna (formerly known as a portion of Electoral Area H and Electoral Area G) as a municipal participating area, and update the new boundary for the participating area portion now known as Central Okanagan West Electoral Area, as shown in Schedule B to include only IR#9 and IR#10.
2. This Bylaw may be cited as Regional District of Central Okanagan Handi-Dart Transit Local Service Area Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 1263, 2009.

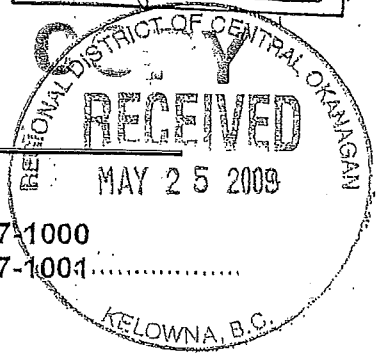

Council at their regular meeting of 2009-MAY-12, advised through a Rise and Report, that the following motion was passed at the 2009-APR-28 In-Camera meeting:


"That Council forward a letter to the Regional District of Central Okanagan (RDCO) formally requesting the Regional Board request the BC Transit Board to designate the District of West Kelowna (DWK) as the provider for the BC Transit Service Agreement, Master Operating Agreement and Annual Operating Agreement for transit services within the municipality; and

That the remaining 2009 Budget requisition for the DWK transit function be transferred to the DWK, once the BC Transit Service Agreement, Master Operating Agreement and Annual Operating Agreement are transferred to the municipality; and

Further that the Regional District amend the Handi-Dart Transit Local Service Establishment Bylaws and Urban Transit Local Service Area Establishment Bylaws to remove the District of West Kelowna from these services".

One of the priorities of Council is to review all servicing agreements in an effort to improve service and increase efficiencies for District of West Kelowna residents. Your cooperation in advancing this Council directive is appreciated. Please let me know if there is anything I can do to assist you with this request.

Dear Mr. Reay,

The District of West Kelowna has approached BC Transit and the Regional District with a request for more direct involvement in transit. At its June 22, 2009 board meeting the Regional District of Central Okanagan passed a resolution of support in principle subject to some conditions.

BC Transit is in support of the request and would like to establish a West Kelowna MOA/AOA as part of the Kelowna Regional Transit System effective April 1, 2010.

The assignment of local government responsibilities and allocation of costs, currently assigned to the Regional District of Central Okanagan, need to be resolved as well there may be internal documents which will need to be amended for both the municipality and the Regional District. BC Transit is in the process of calculating the revised costs per partner and will assist in the transition of local responsibilities if requested.

Work is underway on the Kelowna Regional Master Plan which will guide the service concept and design discussions for the entire transit system in the future. The establishment of this new AOA does not preclude continued discussions with Okanagan municipalities on new service delivery models for transit.


