BYLAW NO. 1265

Being a Bylaw to Amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Bylaw No. 366.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has enacted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Bylaw No. 366;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan considers that it is necessary to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Bylaw No. 366;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. In Part I – General, Section 2 (a) delete the definition for “Poundkeeper” in its entirety and replace it with,

“Poundkeeper shall mean the person or persons appointed from time to time by the Regional Board to be Poundkeeper, a Dog Control Officer, or the authorized agent of any corporation or society, with whom the Regional Board has an agreement to act as Poundkeeper.

2. In Part II – Licensing of Dogs, delete Section 8 (a), (b), (e), and (h) in their entirety and replace with the following:

8. (a) For each spayed female or neutered male dog, where proof is provided that the dog has been spayed or neutered **\$20.00**

- (b) For each unspayed female or unneutered male dog **\$60.00**

- (e) Should such license not be paid by the last day of February of the licensing year, the owner of any dog not so licensed shall pay a further fee of **\$20.00**

- (h) If an owner has a dog spayed or neutered within **six (6)** months from time of purchase of a license in any license year, a refund for the difference in the license fee shall be made providing a valid veterinarian certificate is presented by the owner.

- In Part IV – Impounding of Dogs, delete Section 32.3 in its entirety and replace it with,

“For dogs other than dangerous dogs or aggressive dogs, an impounding fee of \$25.00 for the first impoundment, **\$75.00** for the second impoundment, **\$200** for the third impoundment and increasing **\$200** more for each subsequent impoundment plus applicable license fees and an **additional fee** if the dog is not currently licensed.

The additional fee for a dog that is not currently licensed shall be the same amount as the ticket offence for No Dog License as described in Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990, Schedule 3.

- Delete Section 32.4 in its entirety and replace it with,

32.4 A maintenance fee of **\$20.00 for each overnight detention.**




