The Emergency Operation Centre wants to clarify some misinformation that may be in the community regarding today's Evacuation Order and Alert for properties along North Westside Road within the Regional District of Central Okanagan.

Who is on Evacuation Alert as a result of the Terrace Mountain forest fire?

Approximately 2,200 residents in these communities in the North Westside area are on **Evacuation Alert**:

- Caesar's Landing
- Ewing's Landing
- Nahun
- Valley of the Sun
- La Casa
- Fintry and Fintry Delta
- Killiney Beach

Complete address lists and an accompanying map are posted at the La Casa Vacation Community and Resort and Killiney Beach Community Hall and on the Regional District of Central Okanagan's website at www.regionaldistrict.ca.

Who is on Evacuation Order as a result of the Terrace Mountain forest fire?

The only people who have been evacuated are the 10 properties and 13 people in the 'Fintry High Farm' area. This is the only area that is currently under an Evacuation Order as a result of the Terrace Mountain forest fire.

What is the difference between an Evacuation ALERT and an Evacuation ORDER?

An evacuation ALERT means people can stay at their home but they should be prepared to vacate their home at a moments notice.

An evacuation ORDER means people have been asked to leave their home and will be advised where to check into the Emergency Social Services Reception Centre.
