

Mobile Mapping!

Using ESRI's Explorer for ArcGIS



- **First get the app!**


- Search for and download ESRI's Explorer for ArcGIS onto your smart device.



- **Once it's installed**

- Select the option 'continue without signing in' at the bottom of the first screen.

- **Find our Maps!**

- From the menu choose Find Maps under the Search Function.
- Type in RDCO then choose a map.
- Zoom into your desired location.
- Click the  and it will pinpoint your location.



- **Why use mobile maps?**

- You can view and interact with our live maps and information.
- You are connected to the most current mapping.
- You have the ability to change the base map, turn layers on and off and get information about items by touching the screen.
- You can interact with the data using the sketch feature and make markups directly on the map.

- Depending on your phone you may have slightly different steps than noted above.
- The RDCO does not guarantee that the map services will be available to users without interruption or error. It is dependent on your device's battery life and service provider's coverage.
- This is a live-streaming app that uses **your** data provided by your cell service.
