## 9. DIRECTOR ITEMS

- Chair Given acknowledged the awards presented to the RDCO at the UBCM Conference
  - Economic Development Commission recognized for its leadership and efforts to strengthen agriculture in the regional through its Agriculture Support Program
  - Honourable Mention in the Best Practices, Excellence in Action for the on-going promotion of responsible dog ownership.
- Director Baker presented a picture to the RDCO for the emergency services work on the Okanagan Centre Fire picture during the summer of 2017.
- A video highlighting the recent Black Mountain Parks announcement was shown.
  - The Regional District purchased almost 127-hectares of land to be added to the existing 516-hectares of geographically, ecologically and culturally significant lands that make up the park which prominently towers over Kelowna's eastern boundary-the Black Mountain / sntsk'il'nten Regional Park. The Government of Canada's Habitat Stewardship program contributed \$200,000 towards the purchase and Trust donated Central Okanagan Land \$15.000. the syilx/Okanagan word sntsk'il'nten (sinch-KEEL-en-tin) translates to "the place where arrowheads/flint rock is found". The property has additional First Nation significance because of the wide variety of plants and medicines found in the area. During the park expansion announcement, a special Canada 150 plaque was presented to recognize the generous land donation of the Adria and Holterhus families in 2014 under the Government of Canada Ecological Gifts Program to help create the regional park.
- Director Carson noted children in North Westside must attend school in the Central Okanagan, not Vernon which is closer to the community. Concern has been raised by residents of the 'Parents of the North Westside'. The Director has been encouraged to address the issue with the School District. Any additional information in written form should be provided to the Board for information.
