Job Purpose/Summary:

The Parks Labourer (seasonal) is responsible for setting the level of service for the general public by assisting to provide a safe clean park area for recreation and leisure enjoyment of the public. This position will have primary interaction with the public and requires a friendly helpful demeanor coupled with an interest in working in a parks environment in order to assist in achieving the departmental strategic goals.

Principal Accountabilities:

1. Daily general park maintenance duties such as:
 - Collecting garbage, recycling and litter.
 - Cleaning washrooms, facilities and infrastructure.
 - Daily visual playground inspections.
 - Minor facility and infrastructure maintenance.
 - Completion of inspection/maintenance reports.
 - Provides information and assistance to the publicAssists with:
 - On-going trail maintenance and construction.
 - Natural area management.
 - In-house constructed capital projects.
 - Horticultural activities.
 - Facility and amenity maintenance.
 - General park operation tasks.
 - Delivery of the risk management program.

Educational Background Required:

- Understanding of general facility and infrastructure maintenance and cleaning.
- Basic knowledge of construction techniques.
- Working knowledge in the safe operation of maintenance equipment such as:
 - ATV's
 - Lawn equipment
 - Tractor's
 - etc.
- Time management and organizational skills
- Public relations skills.
- Ability to keep neat and tidy records.
- Physical ability to perform job duties.

Working Conditions:

- **Physical Effort:** Daily medium to heavy lifting
- **Physical Environment:** Majority outside work, exposed to all weather conditions.
- **Mental Stress:** Occasional confrontational situations
- **Sensory Attention:** Consistent requirement to be aware of safety when performing maintenance duties and operating equipment. Be watchful for wildlife on park trails
