Do you love dogs? Are you interested in educating and rewarding responsible dog ownership and behavior? Are you a people person? Do you like spending most of your day working outdoors?

The Regional District of Central Okanagan Corporate Services Department is recruiting for students who are self-motivated, out-going, responsible team players and comfortable with public speaking to fulfill a summer term position as a Dog Ambassador for our Dog Control Service. The students will promote the District's 'Dog Ambassador Program', assist with dog licence checks and with the continuation of the 'My Dog Matters' rewards program.

The **Dog Ambassador program** is aimed at rewarding dog owners on proper dog etiquette, encouraging dog owners to learn about the region's Responsible Dog Ownership Bylaw and dog management in parks and public places. Identified concerns could include off-leash dogs in on-leash areas, failure to properly clean up after dogs, dogs on public beaches, and unlicensed dogs. **This position is about educating and rewarding rather than enforcement.**

The **'My Dog Matters'** rewards program provides discounts on a variety of products and services to licensed dog owners in the Central Okanagan. You will follow-up with existing businesses in this successful program.

This position answers public inquiries and assists with organizing and participating in special dog events in the community. The candidate should be familiar with the Central Okanagan area as much of your days will be spent outside in municipal and Regional District parks and beaches educating and rewarding responsible dog ownership.

A post-secondary student entering the third year of marketing, communications or business administration program is ideal. You must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills and be comfortable speaking to dog owners. Good computer skills using MS Office, natural problem solving skills and the ability to work with limited supervision is essential. This position works in an outdoor environment, in all types of weather, using a supplied bicycle as transportation.

We offer a wage of \$17.00 per hour and a 35 hour work week that will include some weekend and evening work. The term will commence May until the end of August 2019, however we are flexible for school requirements.
