The Parks Services Department has an opening for the summer student position of EECO Interpreter. Reporting to the Supervisor of Community Relations and Visitor Services, this position provides information to visitors at the Environmental Education Center for the Okanagan (EECO) located in Mission Creek Regional Park. You will assist in developing EECO exhibits, create and deliver interpretive programs and events out of both the EECO and Mission Creek Regional Park, and perform administrative duties.

The successful candidate will be enrolled in either Tourism, Outdoor Recreation, Education, Environmental Education, or Environmental Sciences post-secondary education. Employment as an EECO Interpreter Student will require working a flexible work schedule including evenings and weekends, outdoor work in all kinds of weather, and requires that you possess a valid BC Driver's Licence with a record of safe driving. You must provide a satisfactory Police Information with Vulnerable Sector check from Police / RCMP detachment.

Student program eligibility requirements are that you must be currently attending full-time education and returning to full-time studies in the subsequent academic year.

We offer a wage of \$17.00 per hour, 35 hours per week with a workweek schedule of Wednesday to Sunday. The term for this position is from May 6 to August 25, 2019 (16 weeks); however, we are flexible for school requirements.
