



Indigenous Park Guardian/Park Patroller Student

The Regional District of Central Okanagan Parks Services is currently recruiting for a self-motivated and organized individual to fulfill an upcoming work term as an *Indigenous Park Guardian/Park Patroller Student*. Reporting to the Manager of Parks and Resource Operations and supported by Parks bylaw staff, you will patrol and monitor our parks system, promote stewardship of the lands and cultural interpretations that share Okanagan syilx culture, history, language, and traditional knowledge with visitors and the public. During this term of employment, the Indigenous Park Guardian/Park Patroller Student will collaborate with the Parks Team by providing indigenous perspective, knowledge and stewardship of the shareable aspects of the Okanagan syilx language, culture, and history.

The successful candidate must be between the ages of 18 – 30 and returning to full-time high school or post-secondary studies in the fall of 2019. You must have a good understanding and knowledge of Indigenous culture, in particular syilx. The position requires strong written and verbal communication skills and the ability to work with minimal supervision. The schedule for this position is Thursday to Monday from 11:00 am to 7:30 pm. This position requires the ability to traverse and work in outdoor environments and in all types of weather conditions. Candidates must have a valid BC Driver's License with record of safe driving. This position was created through funding from Government of Canada and the Canadian Parks and Recreation Association (CPRA) Summer Work Experience Green Jobs Initiative.

The term for this position is May 6 to August 19, 2019; however, the position can be extended into the fall of 2019 on a part time basis that would include weekend work. We offer a competitive salary of \$17.00 per hour, 40 hours per week.
