Dog Control Officer I (Term)

The Corporate Services Department has a term opening for a Dog Control Officer I. Reporting to the Chief Bylaw Enforcement Officer, this position helps maintain public safety and recognizes that responsible dog ownership is essential to the service. Excellent communication skills and a calm and effective approach when dealing with the public is vital to providing dog control by-law enforcement for the Regional District of Central Okanagan (RDCO).

The Dog Control Officer I is responsible for enforcing the Responsible Dog Ownership Bylaw 1343 through daily park patrols, responding to public complaints, making judgment calls on alleged infractions, issuing tickets, apprehending dogs and investigating alleged violations of the Dog Control Bylaw.

To be successful in this role, you must have completed grade 12 (or equivalent) and Bylaw Enforcement & Investigative Skills (Level I) and hold a valid BC Driver's License with record of safe driving. Experience as a Dog Control Officer is ideal. The position requires experience with understanding dog health, behavior, and handling with the ability to physically restrain dogs, including aggressive dogs. The ability to communicate in a diplomatic & effective manner is essential to educate dog owners about responsible dog ownership, bylaws, and to determine how to proceed in widely varied circumstances. The successful incumbent will have excellent interpersonal skills with a respectful, strong teamwork approach. This position requires flexible work hours and on call availability.

This is full-time, term position to commence immediately and is expected to conclude October 2019, or upon original incumbent, however, there is possibility for term extension. We offer a salary of \$29.54 per hour plus 15% in lieu of benefits.
