Duties include:

- Leading heritage tours
- Answering public inquiries about parks and regulations

Your knowledge of tourism, outdoor recreation, and ecology will help you build appreciation and understanding of special natural and cultural features, and ecological relationships in Regional Parks. The preferred candidate should have a basic knowledge of local, natural and cultural history and experience with program design and delivery.

Employment as a Park Interpreter Student will require working a flexible work schedule including evenings and weekends, outdoor work in all kinds of weather, and requires that you possess a valid BC Driver's Licence with a record of safe driving. You must provide a satisfactory Police Information with Vulnerable Sector check from Police / RCMP detachment.

Student program eligibility requirements are that you must be currently attending full-time education and returning to full-time studies in the subsequent academic year. As per the Green Jobs Canada Grant criteria, successful applicants must be between the ages of 18 – 30.

We offer a wage of \$17.00 per hour, 35 hours per week. This position is to commence immediately.
