The Parks Services Department has a full time opening for a *Parks Operator Zone Team Lead* reporting to the Manager – Park Operations. The Parks Operator Zone Team Lead is responsible for coordinating and overall delivery of the day to day park maintenance activities to ensure that a safe clean park area for recreation and leisure enjoyment of the public is achieved while meeting the departmental strategic initiatives and established policies and standards of the Regional Board. This position will also assist in the delivery of the Regional and Community Parks Regulatory and compliance programs. A seasonal flexible work schedule is required.

To be successful in this role, you will have completed post-secondary education in a program such as Horticulture, Turf Management or Resource Management. Your skills are supported by a minimum of 2 years' experience in a related supervisory role demonstrating knowledge of park operations and maintenance practices preferably in a local government setting. Possessing the Wildlife Danger Tree Assessor Certificate, IAABC Irrigation Level 1 Certificate, Low Voltage Electrical Certificate, Chain Saw Operation Certificate and Level 1 First Aid are required. You must also possess a valid BC Driver's License and have completed the Bylaw Compliance, Enforcement & Investigation Skills 1 course.

This is a full-time position to commence immediately. This position consists of a 40-hour work week, a flexible seasonal daily work schedule including weekend work and is a member of CUPE Local 338. We offer a salary of \$30.25 - \$33.61 per hour along with highly competitive benefits, vacation and pension package.
