

# Westside Residential Disposal & Recycling Centre/Landfill Closure News



January 2011



*This is our monthly update on the operations of the Westside Residential Waste Disposal and Recycling Centre and on the progress of the landfill closure.*

## News and Information

### Residential Waste Disposal and Recycling Centre

- The annual Christmas tree drop off program runs through January 31<sup>st</sup>.
- As required, yard waste and waste wood will be loaded and removed from the site for disposal. Yard waste may require more frequent removal due to increased drop off of Christmas trees.
- The Residential Waste Disposal facility is open Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm (closed Christmas and New Year's days). Please remember that loads must be covered during transport to the facility. All materials previously accepted when the landfill was open are still being accepted including free disposal of up to 250 kilograms of residential yard waste. Please ensure grass, leaves, small branches and pruning's and other garden yard waste dropped off for disposal does not contain plastic bags, sod, rocks or other non-yard waste contaminants.
- West Kelowna, Peachland, Central Okanagan West and Westbank First Nation reserve residents may drop off recyclables at the site seven days a week, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm (closed Christmas and New Year's days).

### Landfill Closure

- As recommended by RDCO consultants, monitoring is continuing through the winter so that they can recommend the most appropriate gas venting system before finalizing the Closure Plan.
- We anticipate receiving the Final Closure Plan during 2011 for Regional Board consideration. Ministry of Environment approval is required for the Final Closure Plan.
- We continue to receive and stockpile suitable soils on the landfill that will be used to establish final grades and contours during the closure process. Sloping may take place in various areas for final grading and elevation.
- We expect to schedule a public meeting in the future to present information regarding the Final Closure Plan and in particular landscaping and ongoing monitoring components.
